The nose is full of complexity and aromatic diversity: red fruits such as raspberries and strawberries, also blue flowers, tobacco leaves, chocolate, vanilla, mushrooms, dates, mint and banana. The wine enters sweet, and gives way to a balanced acidity. Good sized tannins and a long finish. Exquisite classic Malbec of great quality! Violet color with medium intensity.
