Biodynamic wine with expressive aromas. Green pepper, mint, ripe plums, blue flowers, and a hint of vanilla. In the palate it is friendly, with very round active tannins and lively acidity. The oak, which adds complexity, emerges after time in the glass with its notes of coffee and chocolate. Ruby red color with purple reflections, medium intensity.
